- 2965 To give Retrospective approval of use of land licence for the Transition 6 raft race. £50.00 payment made under clerk's emergency powers with the approval of Chairman. If not paid the expenditure on the event already approved by council (and paid) would have gone to waste. *Clerk*
- 2966 To consider an application for a grant aid award of £350.00 from the Patient Care Improvement Group (enclosed)
- 2967 To consider a proposal "In Principle" to bring the Beach Wheelchairs Project under the management of the town council. The final approval to be guided by the production of a business case on the proposal. *Cllr Raynor*
- To consider a proposal to establish an FTC working group to support and oversee the "Back on Track" Project. If agreed to nominate and approve members. *Clirs Stirzaker and Raynor*.
- 2969 To consider a proposal to establish an FTC working party, specifically to investigate the establishment of a Plaza type skate park and BMX track in Fleetwood. If agreed to nominate and approve working party members. *Clir Crawford*.
- **2970** To consider a proposal to create a New Ideas working group and ask for volunteers. If agreed to nominate and approve working party members. *Cllr Conn.*
- 2971 To discuss the idea of creating a Public Forum about Fleetwood called FOCUS ON FLEETWOOD. This would be open to anyone with an interest in the town, Businesses, Wyre Council, Local MP, police, organisations and members of the public. Topics could include Roads, Schools, Empty buildings, Housing, Heritage, Funding, Things for kids to do, Back on Track and many other ideas. Cllr Conn
- **2972** To consider a proposal to appoint a Disability Champion for the Town Council (enclosed). *Cllr George*



- 2973 To consider a proposal that any person/body making a grant application to FTC, must appear at the meeting at which the grant application is discussed, to present the grant application in person and to be available for any questions or points of clarification relating to the grant application. If approved, the necessary amendments be made to the grant aid policy and application form. *Cllr Crawford*
